


## The Infrastructure

- One single bedroom
- Four double bedrooms
- One working room, around 35 sqm
- Two bathrooms with showers and one with a tub
- One extra toilet

Enough tables and chairs for desk work and other, more physical work

- Wifi internet
- A4 black laser printer
- Active desktop speakers
- Beamer

- Well equipped kitchen with dishwasher
- Dining room
- Workshop with a basic range of tools
- Washing machine
- Fireplace

- Patio and garden area
- Parking spaces
- For children: Children bed, baby highchair

### *Please note:*

As an old stone house it is difficult to heat and therefore might be chilly. However there are two fireplaces.

Devices such as computers, scanners and cameras must to be brought by the residents themselves. In exceptional cases we can offer you help to organise this equipment.

We will provide all kind of household items. There is a fee for this, which includes replacements and repairs, the tourist taxes and is to be paid at the end of your residency. It is 150 CHF per person.

## How to get there

Vairano is accessible by car and public transport. There are around five bus connections per day as well as a direct train from Malpensa airport of Milan to S. Nazzaro. The closest bus stop is called «Vairano Paese», which is just around the corner.

Plan your journey early. Check out [sbb.ch](http://sbb.ch) for train connections, in addition to other railway companies. The SBB offer supersaver tickets.

Check the →Google map for places to buy food and materials. The nearest grocery store is in walking distance or a short bus ride away. Supermarkets and hardware stores are also accessible by bus (30 minutes one-way minimum). For shopping a car is definitely worth it, but not necessary if you organise yourselves.

## Your Guests...

...can stay for 25 CHF per night with their own sleeping bag. Children can 15 CHF per night.
